

- 1.1 We have assessed that our activities present a low impact to the environment. However, we aim to maintain the highest standards of environmental care, for both Company and Client. In support of this policy the company is developing and implementing an integrated management system during 2016 which will lead to us being formally 3<sup>rd</sup> party assessed to BS EN ISO 14001.
- 1.2 This will be achieved by meeting the following objectives:
- Increasing and maintaining a high level of environmental awareness of all employees, so that environmental protection becomes a collaborative effort.
  - Senior Management demonstrating a commitment to environmental protection by active involvement and providing adequate resources.
  - Complying with all relevant environmental legislation, guidance and good practice.
  - Pro-actively monitoring and developing innovative means of minimising environmental impact.
  - Encouraging close liaison with the enforcing authorities, such as the Environment Agency and Local Authority.
  - Assessing the impact on the environment from all aspects of our operations to ensure that all suitable and statutory preventative and protective measures are taken to protect the Environment.
  - Development and implementation of arrangements to support this policy statement, based on continuous improvement.
  - Monitoring, measuring and reviewing all arrangements against objectives to ensure they remain effective and current with changing legislation and knowledge.
- 1.3 To maintain effective environmental management, we require the full support and co-operation of all employees and contractors, and that they share these Company values as common beliefs.
- 1.4 This policy will be updated to an integrated policy and will be reviewed annually.
