- 1.6 It is the responsibility of all employees to follow this policy and its supporting procedures.
- 1.7 The aims of this policy can only be achieved will the co-operation and active involvement of all employees.
- 1.8 This policy will be communicated to all employees at induction, the policy and its supporting procedures will be documented in the SHEQ Handbook, which is issued to all employees.
- 1.9 The SHEQ handbook will be will be periodically reviewed and amended to comply with new legislation, codes of practice etc.
- 1.10 Information on health and safety best practice and performance will be communicated to employees using the SHEQ newsletter, toolbox talks, wage packet messages and SHEQ seminars.
- 1.11 The effectiveness of the safety policy and procedures will be monitored by Directors and SHEQ personnel during formal site inspection and audit.
- 1.12 In support of this policy the company will be developing and implementing an integrated management system during 2016
- 1.13 This policy will be updated to an integrated policy and will be reviewed annually.
